



## Student Proposal Assessment

Dear Professor,

Student members of the Evangelical Theological Society, who are enrolled in a Ph.D. program, are eligible to submit a paper proposal for our upcoming Annual Meeting. They are required, however, to provide an assessment of the proposal from one of their professors. To help us evaluate this proposal, please include the following in your assessment:

- Student name and title of the proposed presentation
- The nature of your relationship to the student
- Your level of familiarity with the proposed paper:
  - Have you read the paper?
  - Have you read a larger work from which this paper is drawn (e.g. dissertation chapter)?
- Would you recommend that this paper be included in the program?

Your assessment may be sent in the text of an email or as an attachment. You may send your assessment directly to [meeting@etsjets.org](mailto:meeting@etsjets.org) or you may return it to your student who will then submit it to us. If you submit your assessment directly, it will not be shared with the student. ETS will only grant access to our review committee members.

The proposal period ends Thursday, March 29th at 5:00 PM (CST) and all student proposals must have their assessment letters in before the period ends. Student proposals lacking an assessment will not be considered for inclusion in the program.
