Announces its 2018 Student Paper Competition

Requirements

1. Contestants must be currently enrolled at an academic institution, either undergraduate or graduate. PhD students will submit papers to the regular program.
2. Contestants must be student members of ETS; their paper must be endorsed by a professor who is a full member of ETS; and they must register for and attend the regional meeting if their paper is selected.
3. Papers will be approximately 4,000 words (no more than 20 double-spaced pages), in correct form and free of typos, on a topic of interest relating to biblical or theological studies. Papers may relate to this year's theme, "The Future Direction of Evangelical Theology" but this is **not** a requirement.
4. Previous award winning contestants are not eligible to compete.

Procedure

1. **Submit (via email)** to Prof. Eric C. Redmond **by Friday, December 8, 2017** the following: (a) the title of your paper with one page single-spaced abstract; (b) a paragraph of endorsement from the professor who is mentoring your paper; and (c) the following information: contact data, degrees earned, and current degree program information (include your major).
2. If your proposal is accepted, you will then **submit a completed draft of your paper** (a hardcopy plus a digital version) to Prof. Redmond, **postmarked by January 13, 2018**. Up to six of the best papers (3 undergraduate and 3 graduate) *may* be selected, included in the program, and eligible for an award.
3. If your paper is chosen, you will then **submit a final draft of your paper** (a hardcopy plus a digital version) to Prof. Redmond, **postmarked by February 16, 2018**. You must then register for and read your paper at the Regional meeting at Grace Bible College.
4. **Late submissions for any of the three deadlines will be disqualified.**
